Why is CountyCare partnering with Availity?

Availity Essentials provides a singular provider experience for checking eligibility and benefits, managing claims and completing other secure administrative tasks for CountyCare. CountyCare is partnering with Availity to make transactions easier and simpler and reduce administrative burden.

What is Availity Essentials?

Availity Essentials is an online, multi-payer portal that gives providers, hospitals and other health care professionals access to multiple payer information with your own secure user ID and password.

How do I register with Availity?

To get started with Availity, your organization must first designate an administrator for your office. The administrator is required to register the organization and will be responsible for adding new users to the group's account.
