



COMMISSION ON CANCER

CountyCare understands how important it is to provide our members with high quality care for serious conditions like cancer. If you have been diagnosed with cancer you may receive a referral to a cancer specialist. Below are some simple steps you can follow to make sure you get the best care possible.

Step 1

Check to see if the provider is accredited by the Commission on Cancer (CoC) at <https://www.facs.org/search/cancer-programs>. The CoC is nationally recognized as a mark of high-quality cancer care. CountyCare only approves care at CoC sites. It's helpful to go to the Commission on Cancer website when you need care because providers' accreditation status can change from time to time.

Step 2

Confirm that the provider participates in the CountyCare network by checking <http://www.countycare.com/find-a-provider> or calling member services at 312-864-8200.

If you started your cancer treatment before you joined CountyCare and your provider is not on these lists, you may be able to continue receiving care from them. Your provider should contact CountyCare Utilization Management to determine if they may continue to provide your care.
