It's Time for Open Enrollment!

This fall, you will receive a letter from the State's HealthChoice Illinois program asking you to choose a Medicaid healthcare plan for 2019. If you want to stay with your current CountyCare plan and PCP, you don't need to do anything. If you choose a different plan you will be locked into that plan for 12 months.

Open Enrollment is different from Redetermination. Redetermination also happens once every year to determine whether you are still eligible for Medicaid. You will need to fill out Redetermination forms to keep your coverage.

CountyCare is honored to be your health plan and we hope you will stay with us in 2019.

CountyCare offers:

- **No Copays.** There are no copays for doctor visits, emergency room visits or prescriptions.
- **Choice.** You have access to over 70 hospitals, 4,500 primary care providers and 15,000 specialists.
- Value-Added Benefits. CountyCare has great extra benefits including free LASIK eye surgery for members who qualify, free diapers, free car seats, Weight Watcher vouchers and books for kids with a gift card.

We have great news! CountyCare now covers all LASIK eye surgery costs for eligible members! In fact, CountyCare is the only Medicaid plan in Illinois to cover LASIK surgery.

But is LASIK right for you?

Members who might be eligible:

- Are between 21 and 50 years old*
- Are in good general health
- Have no health issues affecting eyes
- Have no active eye conditions that may affect healing
- Have a stable vision prescription for at least one year
- Do not have severe dry eye or advanced glaucoma
- Are not pregnant or nursing
- Do not have uncontrolled diabetes

* Members over 50 years old with no indication of cataracts, and who meet the health criteria, may be eligible for LASIK surgery and should schedule a general eye exam with an in-network doctor to complete the LASIK Evaluation Form.

If you are interested or want to know if you qualify you should make an appointment with a CountyCare eye doctor. Be sure to fill out your portion of the LASIK

Evaluation Form and bring it with you to your exam. The eye doctor will fill out the rest of the form and send it to County-Care. You can find the evaluation form here:

If you don't have a printer you can call Member Services and they will send you a form.

If you are cleared in your initial exam you will be scheduled for a refractive eye exam. This is a more in depth eye exam that will tell if you are a good candidate for LASIK surgery. If you are determined eligible, your LASIK surgery will be scheduled within 30 days.

All LASIK surgeries are performed at Provident Hospital Eye Clinic.
