## **Your Primary Care Provider**

## is Key to your Health

Your primary care provider (PCP) plays a key role in your health. He/she is your personal doctor. The information for your PCP is printed on your Member ID card. Regular visits to your assigned PCP are the first step to staying healthy. Regular visits can also help avoid future health complications. Your PCP will make sure you receive all the preventative and wellness services you need. If you need to see a specialist for a specific condition, your PCP will also let you know and make the proper arrangements. Your PCP is also reachable 24 hours a day, 7 days a week for urgent medical needs. Because you are a CountyCare member, you do not need a referral to see a specialist or for behavioral health services if seeing a CountyCare provider. Also, with CountyCare, there are no additional costs to see a specialist.

Remember, you can also get a cash reward\* when you visit your PCP. CountyCare members 16 months and older can earn \$25 on their over-the-counter (OTC) Rewards Card for seeing their assigned PCP for an annual check-up.

\*Members have six months from the date the reward is added to their OTC Rewards Card to use the credit. After the six months, the reward will expire.

## **Immediately?**

#### What to do and Where to go

If you need care immediately, call your assigned PCP listed on your Member ID card. These are times where you need prompt attention but it is not life-threatening.

#### Immediate care is not the same as emergency care.

Your PCP will see you within one business day or will tell you where to go to receive care. Some examples include:

- Minor cuts and scrapes
- Sprains and minor injuries
- Fever
- Earache

You should **ONLY** go to the hospital emergency department (ED) for lifethreatening situations or when your PCP advises you to go there. Call your PCP or the 24-hour Nurse Advice Line at 312-864-8200, 711 (TDD/ TTY), and they will help you decide where to get care. If you need help finding a PCP or for questions, call Member Services at 312-864-8200. 711 (TDD/TTY).

### Rewards Spotlight

CountyCare members get extra benefits and rewards on top of regular health care coverage. CountyCare offers rewards to help keep you and your loved ones healthy. You can get car seats, portable cribs, and coupons for free diapers. You can also get free LASIK eye surgery (if eligible) and free Weight Watchers vouchers. When you or your children go to the doctor for certain services, CountyCare will send you a CountyCare OTC Rewards Card in the mail.



#### **Highlights of the OTC Rewards Card Program include:**

#### **FOR KIDS**

 Earn up to \$100 when you take your baby for vaccinations - \$10 for each of the first 10 immunizations

#### **FOR WOMEN**

 Women between the ages of 50 and 74 can earn a \$25 cash reward each year when they get their mammogram

#### **FOR ALL**

If you visit the emergency department (ED)
 or have an inpatient hospital stay for a behavioral health
 problem, you can earn \$20 if you see your PCP within 7
 days after your visit or hospital discharge

#### I earned cash credit, now what?

Activate your CountyCare OTC Rewards Card. You can use it to purchase essential everyday items like aspirin and toothpaste at participating stores including Dollar General, Walgreens, Walmart and more. #### **Back-to-school Immunizations**

Students are expected to resume in-person learning next fall. It is extremely important that your children have all the vaccines they need to start the year successfully. Vaccinations prevent your child from getting serious diseases such as measles.

#### Children returning to school may need to complete:

- A check-up by their assigned primary care provider (PCP)
- ✓ Dental exam
- ✓ Eye exam
- ✓ Proof of required immunizations

You can get all vaccines through your children's assigned PCP. Don't wait until the last minute to make an appointment to see their medical provider. The school year will be here before we know it.

The preferred drug list search tool makes it easy to find medications covered by your plan. The tool also provides information on drug coverage, including when you can only have so much of a drug (quantity limit), when you have to be a certain age to take the drug at (age limit) or if a review of the drug is needed (prior authorization). Talk to your PCP about questions you have regarding your medications.
