



Back-to-school season is upon us. It is critical your child has all immunizations required to start (and remain) healthy during the school year.

Make sure you schedule an appointment with your child's primary care provider (PCP). We will add a \$50 reward on your child's OTC Reward Card once their annual PCP well-check visit is complete! And now your children (6 months to 18 years old) can also earn an additional \$10 reward each year for an annual flu shot (6 months to 18 years old). Your child's school will let you know what is needed to start the school year. Your child may need a school physical, dental checkup and an eye exam. All of these services are covered by CountyCare. Need Urgent Care? Where to Go

CountyCare now partners with more than 100 urgent care centers that you can go to for care instead of the emergency room (ER). Urgent care centers are locations where you go if you need prompt attention but your condition is not life-threatening. Starting September 1, 2022, all Chicago area CVS MinuteClinics will be a part of the CountyCare Urgent Care network. PCP annual visit	\$50 reward
Annual health risk screening	\$50 reward
Flu shot from your PCP, pediatrician, or a pharmacy (children ages 6 months to 18 years)	\$10 reward
Breast cancer screening (women ages 45 to 74)	\$50 reward
Cervical cancer screening (women ages 21 to 64)	\$50 reward
Colorectal cancer screening (members ages 45 to 75)	\$50 reward



Remember, when you or your children receive certain services, CountyCare will send you an OTC Rewards Card in the mail. The card will have a cash credit based on the services you or your children received. Keep your card and CountyCare will add rewards when you receive more qualified services. Medications & Supplies Covered Under CountyCare in 2022

Your doctor may recommend medications or diagnostic supplies that are used to treat medical conditions like pain or allergy relief. Some may be considered over-the-counter (OTC) products. An OTC medication or product can be sold directly to members without a prescription from a doctor. However, if you would like to have the OTC covered at zero cost as a pharmacy benefit, please contact your doctor for a prescription. Your doctor will decide the amount needed. Please talk to your doctor about your choices. Roe vs. Wade: What you Need to Know

The recent news about the *Roe vs. Wade* court case has caused some confusion and concern about access to abortion services. Illinois is a freedom of choice state, and our state laws affirmatively provides a right to reproductive healthcare, including abortion. This state law ensures access to abortion services in Illinois even with the recent reversal on *Roe v. Wade*.

Abortions are a covered service for those enrolled in Illinois Medicaid. Abortion services are paid for by the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) using your HFS Medical Card. If you need assistance finding a provider for abortion services, contact HFS Health Benefits Hotline at 1-866-468-7543, option 4.

COVID-19 Updates

The time is now to make sure your whole family is up-to-date on their COVID-19 vaccines, especially before fall starts. If you haven't already, please consider doing your part to help fight the pandemic. You can earn \$25 on your OTC Rewards Card for getting your first COVID-19 vaccine. All people ages 6 months and older are encouraged to get vaccinated against COVID-19. Booster shots are now available for everyone 5 years and older. Anyone 50 years and older, those aged 12 and older with certain medical conditions, and those who received an initial Johnson & Johnson vaccine can also get a second booster four months after their first booster shot.
