Peer-to-Peer Review – Update

January 1, 2020 all MCOs were required to adopt the Illinois HFS Preferred Drug List to align with the Fee-for-Service program. Beginning January 1, 2022, providers have the ability to request a peer-to-peer review at any time during the Prior Authorization (PA) review process, as well as after the decision is rendered.

Providers are able to:

- Call and initiate a PA
- Call anytime **DURING** the PA review process to discuss the PA
- Discuss the **PA AFTER** the decision is rendered

Peer-to-Peer Review Process:

- Medical Review Institute of America (MRIOA) provides a toll-free phone number (866-397-0197) for prescribers to initiate a peer-to-peer review with an MRIOA Medical Director. MRIOA Medical Director's hours of operation are 9 a.m. CST – 6 p.m. CST. MRIOA Pharmacy staff will check the peer-to-peer message line every 60 minutes.
- Upon calling the toll-free phone number, the prescriber is prompted to leave a message. The recorded message requests the prescriber to leave the following information:
 - Patient name and date of birth
 - PA number
 - Prescriber name and phone number
- The message informs the prescriber an MRIOA Medical Director will return his/her phone call to complete the peer-to-peer within 8 business hours.
- Calls received after hours will be returned the next (business/calendar) day.
- Once a message is received, MRIOA's medical staff will create a new peer-to-peer request within MedImpact's system.
- The patient's case will be verified within MedImpact's PA system.
- The case information will be sent to an MRIOA Medical Director to complete the peer-to-peer request within 8 business hours.
