## **Certificate of Transportation Services (CTS) Form New Requirements**

Beginning with dates of service on or after June 1, 2022, the Certificate of Transportation Services (CTS) form will be required for all residential trips to medical appointments, including dental and vision. The CTS form may be utilized for repetitive trips and is effective for up to 60 days for non-emergency transports originating at a member's private residence and up to 180 days for recurring Medicar/wheelchair van and service car transports. If medical necessity or the level of transportation changes, a new CTS form will be requested.
