COVID-19 Prior Authorization Temporary Changes for SNFs

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic and the recommendations by the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS), CountyCare implemented the following temporary changes on 1/1/2022, the relaxation of prior authorization requirement, which will remain in place until 07/31/2022:

Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF)

- a. Prior authorization not required for first week of post-acute care; the only requirement is notification within 48 hours of transfer to facility
- b. Concurrent review and authorization required after 1st week (7 days) of admit.

The <u>CountyCare Coronavirus Task Force</u> is actively monitoring the evolving coronavirus outbreak, including guidance from trusted sources of clinical information such as the <u>Centers for Disease Control</u> (CDC) and <u>World Health Organization</u> (WHO). Throughout the duration of this public health emergency, CountyCare will make additional changes, as needed, to the prior authorization process.

This notice is intended to provide guidance for in-network facilities. All out-of-network requests are subject to prior authorization, along with Medical Director review, and may be redirected to an in-network facility.
