

CountyCare Health Plan Illinois Crown Benefit Revisions Effective 11/15/2023

TO: Participating Network Practices

DATE: September 15, 2023

Effective for dates of service on and after **11/15/2023**, CountyCare Health Plan is revising the benefit structure for single crowns and related restorative procedures for children and adults by reducing the frequency limitation from one per tooth every 60 months to one per tooth every 36 months, and implementing a benefit to replace broken crowns, for the following CDT codes:

- D2740 crown - porcelain/ceramic
- D2750 crown - porcelain fused to high noble metal
- D2751 crown - porcelain fused to predominately base metal
- D2752 crown - porcelain fused to noble metal
- D2753 crown - porcelain fused to titanium and titanium alloys
- D2790 crown - full cast high noble metal
- D2791 crown - full cast predominantly base metal
- D2792 crown - full cast noble metal
- D2931 prefabricated stainless steel crown – permanent
- D2932 prefabricated resin crown
- D2950 core buildup, including any pins when required
- D2954 prefabricated post and core in addition to crown
