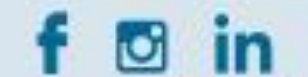
**ACCESS' M.A.R. services include:**

# Medication Assisted Treatment

Available at our Elgin, Hanover Park, Sycamore and Wheeling locations!

This program is available for any adult (18 years and older) who struggles with an Opioid Use Disorder. Patients can be referred to the MAT Program by their insurance, court system, substance abuse and mental health treatment providers, primary care providers, and self-referred. Through the program, participants will receive Buprenorphine (Suboxone) or Naltrexone (Vivitrol) in combination with Level 1 outpatient behavioral health counseling and group therapy. Our MAT Program Is Integrated With Other Essential Services, Including:

- › Primary Health Care
- › Psychiatry
- › Group and Individual Counseling
- › Care Management

You will meet with an MAT Provider to develop an Individualized Treatment Plan that will help you understand which of the services listed above can benefit you. If you need a service we do not provide, we will link you with other services to meet your needs.

## Substance Use Program

Medication and our holistic approach can help lead to change



Opioid Use Disorder and other substance use disorders are a national epidemic. Medication Assisted Treatment, MAT, includes the use of drugs like buprenorphine and naltrexone. More people find that this treatment helps them make the changes they want.

MAT, in combination with psychiatry and primary care, works to empower our patients to navigate thoughts and challenges while reducing and/or abstaining from opioids, alcohol, and stimulants.

- We provide MAT for opioid and stimulant use disorders to all in need. You can be on any insurance plan or no insurance. We are also open to all, regardless of immigration status.
- If you are already a patient, we can provide treatment resources and referrals for recovery services for substance use disorders.

We offer the following medications:

- Buprenorphine (Suboxone, Subutex, Zubsolv)
- Naltrexone (Vivitrol, Depade, ReVia)

In addition to medications, MAT patients can access the rest of our primary care services, prescription discounts, and more.

## CCH Bridge



**COOK COUNTY HEALTH**  
BRIDGE CLINIC

**The Bridge Clinic at Cook County Health is your entry point into recovery.**

We act as an urgent care clinic for those struggling with opioid and/or alcohol use. The Bridge Clinic provides rapid access to treatment without judgement.

Common examples of opioids include heroin and prescription pills like oxycodone (Percocet, OxyContin), hydrocodone (Vicodin), codeine, fentanyl, and morphine.

### Integrated addiction treatment with a prescriber and recovery coach

Commonly prescribed medications:

- Buprenorphine [Suboxone™, Brixadi™, Sublocade™, Zubsolv™] for opioid use disorder
- Naltrexone [Vivitrol™] for opioid and alcohol use disorder
- Naloxone [Narcan™] for opioid overdose\*
- We do not offer methadone treatment but will make a referral when appropriate.

Linkage to other substance use treatment and support services including residential, intensive outpatient, peer support, methadone clinics and recovery homes.
