Transportation Options

- 1. Public transportation bus passes (Ventra 1day, 7days, PACE)
 - Contact Member Services at (312) 864-8200 two weeks in advance
- 2. Fleet Transportation for all appointments to and from CCH
- 3. First Transit Non-Emergency, non-ambulance trips
 - Contact First Transit at 630-403-3210 72 hours prior to appointment
- 4. First Transit FFS Non-Emergency Ambulance
 - Used to be covered by CountyCare but as of 1/1/22 is now covered by HFS
 FFS
 - HFS FFS uses First Transit as a prior approval vendor (not a transportation broker)
 - 877-725-0569 (Monday through Friday, 8am to 5:00pm CST).
 - 7-day notice is preferred
 - In order to have medical necessity for an ambulance the member cannot be in a wheelchair, able to stand/pivot, maintain a seated position
 - Assistance with stairs will not be considered medical necessity

Member Rewards & Benefits Updates



We recently did an in-depth program analysis of our member rewards program. To help increase preventative health measures, along with impacting current and future HEDIS measures, we made the following adjustments to our rewards program.

Member Rewards Overview



- ➤ When a member or their children go to the doctor for certain services, CountyCare will send them a CountyCare OTC Rewards card in the mail.
- The card will have a cash credit on it based on the services they received. Once they activate the card, they can use it to purchase items from several stores.
- Members have <u>6 months</u> from the date the reward is <u>added</u> to their OTC card to use the credit. After 6 months the OTC card will expire.
- Rewards are based on claims and can take *up to* <u>180 days</u> to show up on the OTC card.



- Members can purchase household, health, and food items from participating retailers, but CANNOT purchase alcohol, tobacco, or firearm products.
- Members can also use the Smartphone App to keep up with rewards on their phone.
- They can check their balance, locate stores, or view eligible items and discounts.
- They can also go to https://www.otcnetwork.com/ to review that information.

COVID Vaccine Reward



- ➤ Members can get a free COVID-19 vaccination.
- CountyCare is offering a \$25 reward on the OTC reward card for anyone completing their 1st COVID-19 vaccination dose.
 - > First dose only (no booster)
- ➤ Member needs to submit proof of vaccination
 - ➤ Needs to take picture of proof of vaccine and nine digit member ID number via email to countycare@cookcountyhhs.org
 - ➤ If member does not have smartphone, they can scan a copy at the library and send via email
- ➤ Use https://myshotcookcounty.com/locations/ to find a location to schedule and receive their COVID-19 vaccination.


Brighter Beginnings Program for Expectant Moms and Families

- Free Diaper Coupons
- Free Sleep Safe Kit:
 - Pack 'n Play with a fitted sheet
 - SleepSac
 - Baby Sleep board book
 - Pacifier
- Car Seat Program
- Book Club for Kids

Pregnant women can also get:

- An automatic blood pressure monitor, so women can check their blood pressure at home
- One double electric breast pump per year

Members should talk to their provider to order and have them delivered to their home



Materials available in English, Spanish, and Polish.



- **Diaper program**: Members up to 24 months old who are up-to-date on their immunizations receive a coupon in the mail each month for a free jumbo pack of Jewel-Osco Baby Basics diapers
- Free sleep safe kit: Pregnant members can call Member Services and request a sleep safe kit. Once they have completed at least 4 of their prenatal appointments, CountyCare will ship the free Sleep Safe Kit to their home. The kit includes:
 - Pack 'n Play with a fitted sheet
 - SleepSac
 - Baby Sleep board book
 - Pacifier



- Car seat program: Pregnant women and children up to 8 years old who are CountyCare members are eligible for a free car seat. Parents should call Member Services to request the seat and it will be shipped to the address that they provide. Pregnant women are encouraged to call a month before their due date so the seat arrives in time for the baby's birth.
- **Book Club for Kids:** Parents of **m**embers age 3 through 16 can call Member Services to sign up for our annual book club. CountyCare will mail kids a new book every three months. Kids ages 5 through 16 will receive a \$10 Target gift card along with their book.



Free LASIK Eye Surgery:

- Members between the ages of 21 and 50* who meet the qualifications
- Members should schedule an eye exam with an in-network doctor to complete the LASIK Evaluation Form to begin the process

*Members over 50 years old with no indication of cataracts, and who meet the health criteria may be eligible.

Free Weight Watchers (WW) Vouchers:

Members 13 and older can call Member Services to request vouchers to attend WW meetings

Free Home Pregnancy Test:

- Female members of childbearing age
- Call Member Services and request up to one pregnancy test per month
- Money will either be added to their OTC card so they can purchase a test or a test will be mailed to the address they provide

- CDC recommends everyone ages 5 and older get a COVID-19 vaccine
- Pfizer authorized for children ages 5-11 and 12-17
- Where can children be vaccinated? Pediatricians' offices, hospitals, pharmacies, community events, and dedicated CPS, CDPH clinics, and CCH sites

Young Children Vaccination Information

CDPH has developed resources to connect parents of children <u>6 months through 4 years</u> and <u>5- to 11-year-olds</u> with information about COVID-19 vaccines.

 The CDC recommends that children and adolescents age 6 months and older get a COVID-19 vaccine. The vaccine is safe and effective for children, offered at no cost and widely available throughout the city. Vaccination is the best way to protect our children, friends, and families from COVID-19.

CountyCare COVID Vaccine Reward

- What is the reward?
 - Members who receive their first of two doses or single dose after 8/1/2021
 will receive \$25 on their OTC Reward Card
- How and when do they get their reward?
 - If the member has an active OTC card, the funds will automatically load to their OTC Reward within 30-45 days
 - If the member does not have an OTC card, an OTC card will be mailed to them with 30-45 days
 - Ensure we have member's preferred mailing address on file
- How do members check their OTC Reward Card balance?
 - Members can check their OTC reward card by calling 312-864-8200 or going online to www.MyOTCCard.com



COVID19 Vaccine for Pregnant Members

COVID-19 vaccination is recommended for all people aged 12 years and older, including people who are pregnant, breastfeeding, trying to get pregnant now, or might become pregnant in the future. Pregnant and recently pregnant people are more likely to get severely ill with COVID-19 compared with non-pregnant people. Getting a COVID-19 vaccine can protect you from severe illness from COVID-19.



- CDC recommending COVID19 vaccination for pregnant and breastfeeding people (including booster)
- Care Coordinators: Encourage pregnant members to get vaccinated



Don't Lose Your Healthcare Benefits

- As an Illinois Medicaid member, you have not had to complete your redetermination paperwork in two years due to the pandemic. Illinois Medicaid needs to send you important information about your health coverage. Watch for information in the mail about Medicaid redetermination so you can stay with CountyCare.
- To keep your health insurance, make sure we have your current address on file. Update your mailing address now. It's easy, fast, and free. Call IL Medicaid at 877-805-5312 from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. or fill out an online form (www2.illinois.gov/hfs/address).

Open Enrollment: Stay with CountyCare

- If you have not already, you may receive a letter from the HealthChoice Illinois program. The letter asks you and eligible family members to choose a Medicaid health care plan for the next year. We hope you stay with CountyCare! If you want to stay with us, you don't need to do anything. You will be automatically enrolled with CountyCare.

New Stores to Shop with the CountyCare OTC Rewards Card

- CountyCare rewards you for making healthy choices. Our Rewards Card Program gives you cash credit when you get certain services or complete health screens and provides other free benefits.
- The Rewards Card is simple. Once you see your doctor for services that earn rewards, you will get your CountyCare Rewards Card in the mail. It will have a credit on it. Then every time you earn a reward, CountyCare will automatically load it on the same card. Once you activate your card you can use it to buy home and health items from several stores. Use your Rewards Card at **Dollar General, Walgreens, Walmart and now at Food4Less, Jewel/Osco, Mariano's,** and more! You have six months to use your rewards from the date they are added to your card.

CountyCare Health Fairs

Urgent Care Providers Now with CountyCare

- CountyCare now has two urgent care providers in our network for quick, convenient care. **Urgent care centers are facilities** where you go for care, but your condition is NOT life-threatening.
- If you visit these centers, please remember to ALWAYS follow-up with your assigned CountyCare primary care provider (PCP). Receiving care is critical to achieving the best results for your health. Please call the closest location to confirm hours of operation before you go.

WellNow

- Starting June 1, CountyCare members can receive quality care from six WellNow Illinois locations. Visit a WellNow location for:
- COVID-19 testing
- 24/7 virtual care
- Minor injuries and sprains
- Fever
- Common illnesses like colds and the flu




