## Correction: Change to Ordering, Referring, and Prescribing (ORP) Policy, Effective 8/1/2020

Dear CountyCare Provider,

Effective August 1, 2020, Illinois Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is reimplementing the federally required Ordering, Referring and Prescribing (ORP) policy. This federal requirement mandates that all services ordered, referred or prescribed to a Medicaid member must be performed by a clinician registered in the Illinois Medicaid Program Advanced Cloud Technology (IMPACT), which is the web-based provider enrollment platform. Please be aware that your prescription request will be denied if you are not enrolled in IMPACT.

To alleviate the concern of CountyCare members not receiving their medications on August 1, 2020, we have implemented a process that will allow the dispensing pharmacist to submit an override for the requested medication where applicable at the Pharmacy.

If you are a prescriber not currently registered with IMPACT, we urge you to call them right away at 877-782-5565 to enroll.
