## Pharmacy Provider Updates

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) has approved pharmacists, enrolled as provider type 105, to render and bill for additional assessment and consultation services when registered under the appropriate category of service. ### Examples include:

- Pharmacists enrolled under Category of Service 103 can render contraceptive assessment and consultation services.
- Pharmacists enrolled under Category of Service 132 can render HIV pre- and post-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP/PEP) assessment and consultation services.
