Prior Authorization Change Effective 1/22/25

CountyCare Health Plan is committed to providing efficient and consistent Utilization Management (UM) experiences for our members and providers. We continue to review our prior authorization (PA) lists to ensure they are up to date with current fee schedules.

Effective 1/22/25, the following HCPCS codes managed by EviCore no longer require PA.

HCPCS	Description
• E0570	Nebulizer, with compressor
• E0575	Nebulizer, ultrasonic, large volume
• E0580	 Nebulizer, durable, glass or autoclavable plastic, bottle type, for use with
	regulator or flowmeter

EviCore is still responsible for PA for other durable medical equipment (DME) codes as listed in the PA Look Up Tool that can be found here.

- To request prior authorization for DME that is on the PA list and requires PA, you can access the EviCore web portal and build a case at https://evicore.com/Pages/ProviderLogin.aspx.
- PAs are accepted 24 hours a day, seven days a week, excluding planned down time for system maintenance, through the EviCore website, by telephone at 866-525-5029 or by fax to 866-663-7740.
- For telephone requests, the business hours are 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. E.T., Monday through Friday.

This notice is intended to provide guidance for in-network facilities. However, all out-of-network requests are subject to PA through EviCore. Out-of-network requests may be redirected to an innetwork provider whenever possible and will be subject to physician review.
